The Children's Cancer Centre Parent Advisory Group (CCCPAG) is composed of parents and Children's Cancer Centre (CCC) staff working towards improved service within the CCC. The group is primarily composed of parents of children that are having, or who have had, treatment at the CCC. Between them they have experience of many different types of cancer and other serious diseases treated by the CCC. One member of the group is a bereaved parent. The role of the CCCPAG is to act in an advisory capacity to the CCC and to take on an advocacy role where necessary. The CCCPAG will also be in contact with the broader cancer community and other related groups involved in similar issues. Meetings are held monthly.

We invite you to share your concerns about what's happening for you and your family - what's working well and what's not - in your interaction with our unit and your RCH experience. We respect your confidence and may be able to take up issues or give feedback on your behalf.
