

## Bone Marrow Donor Management Checklist

### 1. PURPOSE

This work instruction is a summary of actions describing management of Bone Marrow Donors in the CCC Ward.

### 2. ACTIONS

**2.1 The Donor will go to Theatre via Pre Surgical Ward and would have had pre-op assessment at last outpatient visit with Physician.**

- Donor should be haemodynamically stable.

Hb >90g/L, WBC >4.0x10<sup>9</sup>/L, N >1.0x10<sup>9</sup>/L, Plt >150 x10<sup>9</sup>/L.  
Consult HSCT Physician if the donor does not meet **ANY** of these criteria.

### 2.2 Post Bone Marrow Harvest

- The CCC Ward Registrar or RMO will review the donor and ensure that post-op orders have been completed on the donor's Medicine Chart inclusive of antiemetics, IV fluids, analgesics and diet. Post op Pathology investigations are ordered as appropriate.

**NOTE:** Blood Transfusion **SHOULD NOT** be given. Consult HSCT Physician / Fellow as required.

- The donor should remain supine and the dressing on the aspiration site(s) should not be removed.
- The donor is discharged and post op evaluation is arranged as required.
