



Early Childhood Professional Development Modules

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About the modules:

The Centre for Community Child Health with funding from The RE Ross Trust has developed a series of CD ROM-based professional development modules. These are designed for use with staff who work with young children and families. Each CD ROM contains all the materials needed for a facilitator/leader to deliver a 3-hour workshop. These include facilitator's notes, overhead / powerpoint presentation, video clips, handouts, background reading, and reference materials.

The topics covered are:

- ***Underlying factors influencing child health and development and family functioning (How Children Grow and Develop)***

This module presents an overview of the key factors influencing the development of young children, the main developmental challenges they face, and the factors that affect the functioning of their families.

- ***Family Centred Practice – an introduction (Partnerships with Parents: Listening and Responding To Families)***

This module covers the principles and rationale for family-centred practice, explores challenges in implementing this approach, and to considers the implications for practice.

- ***Identifying and Responding to Child and Family Needs (Understanding the Benefits of Early Identification and Intervention)***

This module discusses child and family needs and how they can be met effectively. It provides a rationale for early identification and early intervention, and discusses methods of helping families identify needs and the implications of these for practice.

This module presents the key principles involved and skills needed to work effectively with communities. These skills are essential for agencies in developing services that are responsive to the collective needs of families and of young children.

This module describes the principles of effective service delivery. It also provides the rationale and principles of effective interagency collaboration and the development of effective service systems.

This module focuses on the rationale and principles of inclusive practice in mainstream services. It explores the nature and role of specialist services in supporting mainstream services.
