

Fellowship in Paediatric Gastroenterology, Hepatology and Clinical Nutrition

The Department of Gastroenterology and Clinical Nutrition at the Royal Children's Hospital, Melbourne is seeking a full time Clinical Fellow commencing in March 2010. The position is for 12 months and is available ONLY to non-Australian trained doctors and is designed for trainees who have successfully completed general paediatric training in their country of origin to a suitable level. The successful candidate will be from an Asian, African, Pacific island or South American country. This position will be appropriate for trainees wishing to pursue a clinical practice, which includes paediatric gastroenterology.

A score of 7 must be achieved in all parts of the International English Language Test; a copy of University transcripts, a curriculum vitae and two professional referee reports are imperative.

The Department provides a statewide service for children with a wide range of gastroenterological conditions, transplantation and clinical nutrition. There is an active clinical research program.

The successful applicant will join a medical team including 9 gastroenterologists and will undergo formal training in all of the clinical skills offered by the department. Individual and collaborative research projects will be encouraged.
