

Newborn Emergency Transport Service

We are moving your baby to another hospital because:

- the hospital where your baby was born cannot provide the care your baby needs.
- your baby needs to go to a hospital that can give the care that your baby needs.

About NETS

- the NETS team, who is moving your baby, is specially trained to look after babies who are being moved.
- it is not always possible for you to travel with your baby; we will tell you if it is.
- if you can't travel with your baby, we will tell you which hospital your baby is going to.

Being with your baby:

- if you are still a patient, you may be transferred to the same hospital as your baby.
- when your baby is well enough, it is usually possible to move your baby to a hospital that is closer to your home.
- when you can't be with your baby, be assured that your baby is receiving the best possible care.
