

### Paediatric Resuscitation as a Refresher

- o Asthma and croup
- o Fractures
- o Bites and stings
- o Head injuries
- o Convulsions
- o Bleeding and dislodged teeth
- o Burns and scalds
- o Poisoning
- o Calling an ambulance
