BLOOD PRODUCT RELEASE

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 1 Transfusion of fresh products (WB, RBC, FFP) must start within 30 minutes, otherwise unit must be returned to the Blood Bank for appropriate storage.
- 2 All fresh products must be signed out in the Register by the person collecting the product.
- 3 Red cells are issued one unit at a time except in the case of massive haemorrhage.
- 4 Fresh Frozen Plasma (FFP): Blood Bank requires a minimum of 30 minutes to thaw plasma prior to transfusion.
- 5 For administration of Rh immunoglobulin, the patient must be Rh Negative, with no pre-formed Anti-D.
