## Errata for Paediatric Injectable Guidelines 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition

On page 62, under "Gentamicin", it should read:

"PN solutions that contain heparin 1 unit/mL or weaker" NOT 1mg/mL

On page 15, under "Ceftriaxone", in addition to the current entry it should read:

Incompatible with solutions containing calcium, including parenteral nutrition, Ringer's and Hartmann's solutions.

**Neonates less than 28 days of age:** Do NOT administer intravenous ceftriaxone and intravenous calcium-containing products – by the same or different infusion lines or sites – within 48 hours of each other.

Patients older than 28 days: Ceftriaxone and products that contain calcium may be administered sequentially (or concurrently via **completely seperate** lines), as long as infusion lines are throughly flushed between infusions with a compatible fluid.

On page 62, under "**Drugs COMPATIBLE with RCH Parenteral Nutrition**", **ceftriaxone** should be deleted or striked out.

On page 63, under "**Drugs INCOMPATIBLE with RCH Parenteral Nutrition**", ceftriaxone should be added to this list.

On page 41, under "Palivizumab", the strength should read:

"50 mg (*negligible*), 100 mg (*negligible*)" **NOT** 50 mg (*0.4 mL*), 100mg (*negligable*)
