VFPMS FEE SCHEDULE

- 1 Commencement Date:
- 2 Term: 3 years
- 3 The Services to be provided by the provider.
- a) The provider is to provide high quality Paediatric Clinical Forensic Medicine and related services including:
 - assessment of individuals aged less than 18 years who have allegedly been involved in assaults, abuse or neglect;
 - obtaining of biological samples;
 - providing advice on psychiatrically disturbed or intellectually impaired persons (where no other appropriate services are available); and
 - other medical services as requested by the Director of VFMPS, or nominee;
- b) The provider is required to give evidence incourt as required;
- c) The provider is required to be aware of legislation and literature relevant to their duties
- d) The provider is required to participate ineducational activities in the field of paediatric clinical forensic medicine; and
- e) The provider is required to perform all other tasks and duties related or incidental to the provision of their services.

4 Service Delivery Timeframes

- a) The provider must provide services within the agreed service delivery time frames including:
 - the submission of medico-legal reports to VFPMS for review within 10working days from case consultation
 - the provision of a final report to Victoria Police and/or Child Protection within 20 working days of case consultation
 - attendance at sexual assault examinations within 2 hours of request
 - attendance at all other cases within 3 hours of request or as otherwise mutually arranged with Victoria Police and/or Child Protection.
 - b) Where service delivery timeframes cannot be achieved, provide explanation for the delay to the Director VFPMS or nominee.

5 Contract Fee:

The Contract FEE will be calculated as follows:

a) Case attendance

Case attendance will be paid at the rate of \$150.00 per hour for a minimum of 2.5 hours.

Case attendance shall begin from the time the provider leaves his/her place of residence or work to the time the provider returns to his/her place of residence or work.

b) Travel

When a provider uses his/her private motor vehicle for work related activities, the rate of \$0.74 cents per kilometre will be paid. A limit of 5000kms claimed in any one financial year applies.
