Brief Instructions for Lumbar Puncture

SUPPLIES: (We use here) LP Tray kit, Adult, and <u>substitute</u> with a 24-25 Gauge Whitaker pencil point needle (Abbott Laboratories). This Whitaker needle lessens the risk of post LP headache.

DAY OF PROCEDURE: Have the patient lie down for at least 30 minutes prior to LP (optional). Have patient lie down for 1-2 hours following the LP draw (or whatever you recommend).

DRAW: Collect a total of 6 to 8 ml and put them in successive 2 - 3 ml fractions numbered 1-3. Note Time of the day, Patient name, DOB, Height and Weight.

SHIPPING: The same day as drawn via FED EX overnight. Do not send on Friday.

ADDITIONAL INFO: Please draw a <u>blood sample</u> – 2 red top tubes 10ml. (empty of additive) and 6 light yellow top tubes 8.5ml. (ACD solution A) and have the subject complete the <u>Stanford Sleep Inventory</u>
