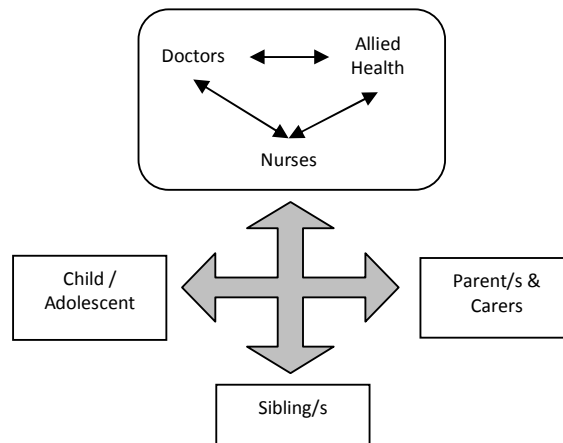
CALL FOR ABSTRACTS
