Laying the Foundations is a new eLearning course that provides an overview of early childhood learning and development from 0-8 years.

Developed by the Centre for Community Child Health, the course focusses on the dynamic interaction between child health, learning, development and wellbeing.

Laying the Foundations is informed by the science of early brain development, current research and practice-based evidence; and provides multiple interactive learning opportunities with current information and resources about young children and their families.

The course aligns with current early years quality frameworks, including the National Quality Standard and Framework, the Early Years Learning Framework, the Victorian Early Years Learning and Development Framework and the Framework for School Age Care.

Modules

Laying the Foundations has five modules. Each module takes between 20-40 minutes to complete.

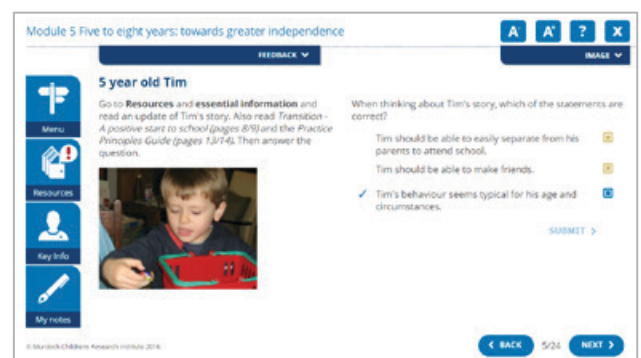
Module 1: Introduction to child learning and development – current perspectives on child health, learning, development and wellbeing.

Module 2: More about child learning and development – factors that impact on child health, learning, development and wellbeing, and parent wellbeing and family functioning.

Module 3: Prenatal to three years – becoming curious about people and the world around them.

Module 4: Three to five years – participating in an expanding social world.

Module 5: Five to eight years – towards greater independence.
