The subject content will be provided over a 5-week period. During the 5-week teaching period you will have time and support to complete the group work activity.

Venue: Online

Learn about the factors that influence children's health, development, wellbeing and life course in the Child Public Health professional development program. This program will help you to respond effectively to child public health issues in your community and work environment.

Available as professional development or through the University of Melbourne's Master of Public Health, the program is coordinated by The Royal Children's Hospital Centre for Community Child Health.

Using the ecological model as a framework, you will explore contemporary child health issues including:

- the impact of poverty and disadvantage
- Indigenous issues
- cross-cultural issues
- nutrition
- mental health
- integrated service delivery
- education and care environments
- child-focused policy development.

Lectures are presented by experienced child public health researchers, policy officers and practitioners.

If you have an interest in children's health and wellbeing, public health, community and child health and community paediatrics, this course is a must for you.
