## Oseltamivir (Tamiflu) Doses in Children

Available as: 12 mg/mL mixture or 75 mg capsules

## Treatment dose:

	23 to 40 kg	60 mg bd for 5 days	The bottle comes with a dispenser marked for 30, 45 & 60 mg. For 75 mg measure 30 mg + another dose of 45 mg.
	>40 kg (adult dose)	75 mg bd for 5 days ( <i>or</i> one 75 mg capsule bd for 5 days)	

**Post-exposure prophylaxis dose:** Same doses and volumes as above but once daily for 10 days

Infants < 3 months: prophylaxis not recommended unless the situation is deemed critical due to limited data on use in this age group
