



Distraction items available from the Comfort Kids Program

	These rattles are durable and are various colours with the balls falling through the different levels. They are useful for distraction by their colour, noise and the feel of them.
	Glitter Wands are a good distraction tool as they engage children through the various colours moving through the tube.
	Groan wands make a groaning sound when the wand is flipped upside down. Children like making the different noises and can be distracted through the use of the wand.
	Haha Groan Hammers makes quacking and squeaking sounds when shaken. Easy for children to create their own noise throughout a procedure.
	Hand Clappers are a noisy tactile item that children can use to distract themselves during a procedure.
	Single Windmills help to promote breath control and can be used as a distraction tool as they are bright and colourful.

	Multi windmills help to promote breath control and can be used as a distraction tool.
	Expander balls are useful for helping children visualise breathing techniques as well as distracting tactile children
	Squeazy stress balls are a fabulous distraction tools for children to use but also to divert children's attention during a procedure.
	I Spy books have riddles to accompany each page of hidden objects. These come in a variety of titles and will be distributed at random.
	Look and Find books have images of lost items and children need to find them throughout the pages. These come in a variety of titles and will be distributed at random.
	Spot What books have a These come in a variety of titles and will be distributed at random.
	First Look and Find books have card pages and are more suitable for younger aged children. These come in a variety of titles and will be distributed at random.

	Noise books are helpful for distraction as children can interact with the story by pressing the buttons. These come in a variety of titles and will be distributed at random.
