

MEDICAL ALERT: I have Hirschsprung Disease

Please contact my surgical team at **The Royal Children's Hospital** on (03) 9345 5522 if I present with vomiting, diarrhoea and/or a bowel obstruction, as I may need to be treated for enterocolitis.

Hirschsprung-associated enterocolitis (HAEC) is a common, and potentially life-threatening

complication of Hirschsprung disease (HD).

HAEC may present with:

- Explosive diarrhoea
- Vomiting
- Abdominal distension

- High temperature
- Lethargy
- Shock
