- You must apply via the Gastroenterology Fellowship advertisement on The Royal Children's Hospital recruitment website by the specified closing date.

- Adverts will be released in late May each year for the fellowship, which will commence the following February. The start date is not negotiable.

- **Please note that applications for an interview will not be considered unless the applicant has met AHPRA's requirements for English language proficiency.**

You will be required to meet AHPRA registration standards regarding your English language skills.
