

Paed-Forum Guidelines

The list is for discussion of difficult clinical cases, and topical paediatric issues.

It is predominantly for paediatricians and paediatric trainees, although other child health care professionals are welcome to join the group.

The list is not moderated – everything you write will go to the group uncensored.

Please:

- Please do not use it for advertising jobs or anything else.
- If you are unsure if something is suitable for the forum – send it to me instead.
- Ensure that patients are not identifiable in the details you post, or that you have their consent to put them on the list
- Don't use the list as an opportunity to ride your hobby horse/s
- No email attachments (messages over 60k will be bounced to avoid attachments)
- Quote selectively: it is usually helpful, especially when the list is busy, to quote specific parts of other messages to which you are responding. This is much better than simply copying the whole of the previous message, which may well contain copies of all of its predecessors too, when most members will have seen all the preceding messages anyway.
- Keep messages short.
- Remember the audience is international – don't be too parochial
- Don't include long email signatures, confidentiality footers etc
- Send plain text messages rather than HTML encoded ones.
- Be considerate of other list members
