Cockatoo, Koala, Platypus, Sugar Glider, Kelpie, Possum	2	Parents, guardians and siblings
Kookaburra	2	Parents, guardians and siblings (RAT required)
Rosella	2	Parents and guardians (RAT required)
Butterfly	2	Parents and guardians (RAT required)
Dolphin	1	Parents and guardians
Theatre and Recovery	1	Parents and guardian
Specialist clinics, Medical Imaging, Day Units	1	Parents and guardians
Emergency Department	<i>One parent/guardian may stay with patients in the waiting room. For patients moved to a cubicle, two people may visit.</i>	
Banksia	<i>As determined by the patient's treating team</i>	

Weekends and public holidays

Extended family and friends can visit on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays, with a limit of two per day.

Possum	2	Parents, guardians and siblings.
Kookaburra	4	Parents, guardians, siblings and others* (RAT required)
Rosella	2	Parents and guardians (RAT required)
Butterfly	2	Parents and guardians (RAT required)
Dolphin	1	Parent or guardian
Theatre and Recovery	1	Parent or guardian
Emergency Department waiting area	<i>One parent/guardian may stay with patients in the waiting room. For patients moved to a cubicle, two people may visit.</i>	
Banksia	<i>As determined by the patient's treating team</i>
