

## **WELCOME TO THE BUTTERFLY WARD**

To maintain a high standard of care for your baby we ask that you follow these guidelines -

- Quiet time is between 12-2pm daily, only parents permitted at this time.
- No visitors allowed when parents not present-unless prior arrangements have been made with the bedside nurse.
- Maximum of 3 people only are permitted at the bedside at any one time.
- Children under 12 years can only visit if they are siblings of the patient. Under no circumstances can other children visit.
- No food or hot drinks are permitted in the patient's room.
- Mobile phones are to be on silent and calls to be taken outside the patient's room near the Family Room.
