

The **La Trobe Eye Clinic** offers a range of evidence-based assessments and interventions for disorders of vision, eye alignment and binocular vision in children and adults.

Part of the School of Allied Health, Human Services and Sport the clinic is a provider of clinical placements for students enrolled in Orthoptics at La Trobe University. The clinic usually operates on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday and assessments are performed by students who work under the supervision of a qualified and experienced orthoptist.

Our mission is to provide high quality patient centred care to the community which is grounded in evidence-based orthoptic practice. We aim for our graduates to be leaders in their discipline and to be skilled, innovative and reflective orthoptists with a commitment to excellence in eye health care and to ongoing professional development.

The clinic offers a range of orthoptic services including a collaborative service with the Royal Children's Hospital (RCH). RCH patients eligible for a referral to the La Trobe Eye Clinic will be comanaged by the University and the Hospital under an agreed set of protocols.

The fees for service are as below. Please note services offered by the University are not refundable through Medicare or private health insurance.
