Who are we?

Melbourne Eyecare Clinic is a teaching clinic providing primary eye care services to the public. We are located at the University of Melbourne.

Eyecare for the whole family

We provide comprehensive eyecare for the whole family including babies, infants, young children, and primary school aged kids. Our Children and Binocular Vision Clinic is run by optometrists with high level of expertise and experience in paediatrics, binocular vision disorders and visual processing conditions.

Our services include assessment and management of:

- Vision and refractive error
- Colour vision, eye focusing and co-ordination
- Strabismus (eye-turn) and amblyopia
- Vision therapy
- Visual processing
- Myopia (near-sightedness)
- Post-concussion vision and eye health
- Allergic eye disease, red eyes, watery eyes and swollen eyelids.

We work with ophthalmologists, including those at the Royal Children's Hospital to achieve timely patient care and optimal patient outcomes.

We offer a wide range of spectacle frames and lenses suitable for children.

Accessible eye care

We believe in patient-centred care that is affordable. Diagnostic imaging is provided for children at a reduced cost, and Medicare bulk billing is available. Children also receive discounts on eyewear. By attending a teaching clinic, you support the development of future eyecare clinicians.

Is Melbourne Eyecare Clinic right for me?

- You require special transport arrangements, such as an ambulance.
- You require translation services. Translators are not available currently.
