

# Paediatric Infant Perinatal Emergency Retrieval (PIPER) Paediatric Parent Information Sheet



PIPER Paediatric is a specialised paediatrics transport service with over 46 years' experience. The PIPER doctors and nurses use specialised medical equipment to safely transport sick children to either a Paediatric Intensive Care Unit, Ward or an Emergency Department located at the Monash Children's or Royal Children's Hospital and occasionally to other hospitals.

PIPER will respond as quickly as possible however response times may be affected by weather conditions, or availability of transport teams or the scheduling of Ambulance Victoria road or air ambulances.

Although the PIPER equipment may look overwhelming, it helps us give the best possible care for your child. The PIPER team will explain the treatment given and address any questions or concerns you may have. We will make every effort to ensure you have time with your child before we leave.

If possible, one parent may be able to travel with your child. The PIPER team will discuss this with you.

You will receive a Parent Information Brochure from the PIPER team, which will include the destination hospital's contact information.
