BrowZine

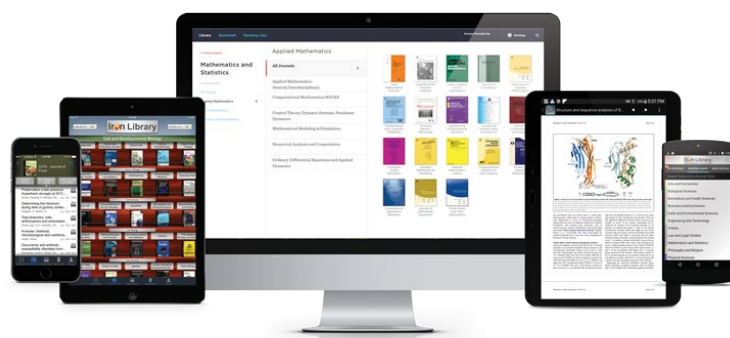
[BrowZine](#) is a journal platform aimed at keeping you up to date with the latest issues of all your favourite journals.

The app is fully integrated with the Library's journal database, which ensures you see only those titles where access is available.

See this [brief video tutorial](#) outlining the main features. An [OpenAthens account](#) is required.

Features:

- Find titles by subject, alphabetically, or sorted by SCImago Journal Rank.
- Use *My Bookshelf* to follow titles of interest and be notified when new articles are published (free user account required).
- Access journals from the web, or on iOS and Android devices.



- See your saved content on any device when logged in.
- Read saved articles offline (on mobile devices).
- Send references to your bibliographic management program, such as Endnote.
- Share citations with colleagues.

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Library Update

Important updates to Clinicians Health Channel (CHC): remote access and changed resources

From 1st July, 2026, the [CHC](#) has a new resource provider; this will bring in a raft of changes.

Remote access changes at the CHC website

- All Medical Director remote access accounts previously created at CHC will cease to function after 30th June, 2026.
- You must create an [OpenAthens account at the CHC website](#) to access resources directly from their website. *If you have an existing OpenAthens account with RCH Library*, this means you'll need to manage two accounts.

All CHC resources will be available from the RCH Library website

We recommend you access CHC resources from the [Library website](#). This means you will need only one [OpenAthens](#) account.

You will find CHC resources integrated with our [databases](#), in our [books catalogue](#), or in our [journals database](#).

New and changed CHC resources

New resources include: **DynaMed** and **Isabel** (point of care tools); **Psychiatry Online** and the **DSM5**; **Micromedex: Standard, NeoFax and Paediatrics**; and **Psychotropic Drug Directory**. These will all be available from the Library website.

Some resources to be removed include **Nursing journals** from OVID, and **Emcare**.

EndNote Tip: export an EndNote library to Excel

You can export the information from your EndNote library to a tab-delimited file and then import that into Excel. Briefly, the steps are:

1. Install a new style and backup your library
2. Create a text file of your library
3. Import the saved text file into Excel
4. Check the imported data
5. Fix the data in EndNote then import again.

What you can donate, in new or gently used condition:

0-6 years - (current shortage in this area)

- Toy/activity books - interactive, touch and feel and bath books, lift-the-flap and board books.
- All types of picture books, ABC activity/picture books, numbers activity/picture books, bedtime/story-time books (to be read by adults)
- Readers level 1-15 are highly sought after!
- Colouring books – educational or craft type

7-12 years - Early readers

- All types of picture books (with longer stories than the above category, very basic readers, educational nonfiction (health, science, geography, flora, fauna, cultural, etc.) and basic junior fiction.
- Colouring books and stickers
- Educational/activity books (to improve skills in maths, reading, writing)

12+ years - Reference/Teachers manuals

- Reference books such as: Atlas, children's dictionaries (all types), children's encyclopaedia, etc. We do not need fiction or nonfiction books at this stage.

Posters: flags, ABCs, 1,2,3s, flora/fauna, maps, body parts, nice pictures of something educational, etc.

Toys: puzzles; jigsaws; flash cards; baby wooden toys; board games; puppets; educational stacking blocks; and pull-along toys.

clinical medicine.

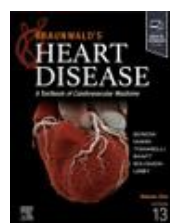

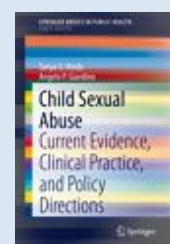

Prevention of child sexual abuse is very different than prevention of child physical abuse and neglect and requires a different framework and set of initiatives.

This book is a must-have resource for a range of professionals including healthcare providers, child advocates, clinical social workers, public health officials, mental health providers, and legislative staff professionals.

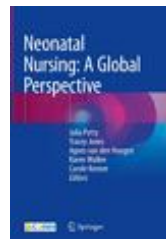

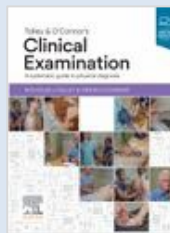

For each region, education and competencies, challenges and opportunities, research and evidence-based practice (EBP) as well as practice regulations are described.

The second part elaborates on key topics for neonatal nursing across the globe, such as the continuity of neonatal care in the community, patient and family centered care in neonatal settings, sleep and brain development, the fundamental care needs of the neonate and family and global perspectives on hypothermia, hypoglycaemia and hypoxia.

Written in a formal academic but reader style, using key literature and evidence, this textbook enables an understanding from a large audience with academic levels and experience, both staff and students, bedside nurses, advanced practice nurses, midwives and allied professionals. In addition, first person story based reflective narrative are interspersed throughout the book to capture the perspectives of nurses, staff and parents, in the form of vignettes.
