## 5.3 Medically unwell children

Medically unwell children are vulnerable to the effects of procedural pain as they may experience an increase in medical procedures in conjunction with decreased physiological reserves. Remember to:

- Ensure all medical procedures are necessary medical procedures
- Cluster necessary medical procedures where possible
- If a child is to unwell to leave their room, create a "safe place" by providing procedure free periods
- Children may become withdrawn when unwell and have reduced capacity for communicating procedural distress. Do not presume a quiet child is coping well with medical procedures.
